Location

The Patina, Capitol Singapore is located in the heart of the city’s downtown Civic and Cultural district, with close proximity to dynamic landmarks and arts venues such as the National Gallery, the Singapore Art Museum, the Esplanade and the Marina Bay area. It is conveniently accessible, being a mere 17-minute (18.2km) drive from the Singapore Changi Airport and a 2-minute walk to City Hall MRT station.

The neoclassical-style Capitol Wing comprises 101 rooms and 5 suites, while the elegantly Victorian Stamford Wing comprises 33 rooms and 18 suites including the Bidwell Suite and Patina Suite.

A 24-hour stay promise is extended to guests who book a stay in the Stamford Rooms, and any of our Stamford, Bidwell and Patina Suites, where they can enjoy an exclusive 24-hour stay regardless the time they check in to ensure that they receive the full rest desired.
